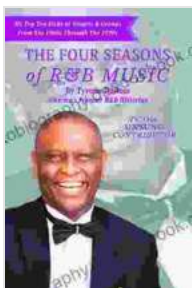

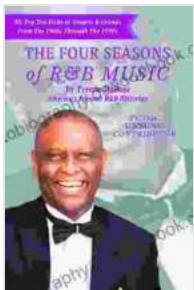
9. Duran Duran
